**Board Meeting:** The regular meeting of the Klasy Kruisers Car Club was held at the Village Inn in Ames, IA on Tues, Mar 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7 pm and the meeting was called to order by Tony Caponigro.

**Secretaries Report-** The Secretaries report was shared with those present and No Board Action was taken to approve the minutes, as we did not have a quorum.

**Treasurers Report-** The Treasurer's report was stated "as the previous month" for a total of \$2573.74 with an expenditure of 50.00 paid to a Memorial fund for member Ray Elsberry and No Board Action was taken as this was covered in the Clubs Policy & Guidelines. However, \$25.00 was so noted in 2013 and earlier reviewed in 2008 as \$50.00 to be given for Flowers or as a Memorial. After having reviewed this with several members, it was agreed that the amount should be re-set to \$50.00 for this expenditure. No board action was needed, and Tony agreed to update the Clubs Policy & Guidelines for future reference.

## Club Business:
